- 1. Complete the Allied Health Education department application. This is how we identify you as an Allied Health student and contact you with important updates or information.
- 2. Review the Allied Health Handbook on the Allied Health Education website.
- 3. Please set up an appointment with Tami Mattox or Justin Henderson as soon as possible; at the latest during your first quarter if an enrollment services advisor or navigator helped you your first quarter.
- 4. English 99 level and Math 96 level.
- 5. Before practicum you will need proof of several immunizations and negative TB test. These can take months so get started now.
- 6. Additional requirements will be addressed in specific program courses.
- 7. On completion of prerequisites students must submit application to pharmacy technician program for fall start. Application is available on the Allied Health Education website.
- 8. We recommend taking additional courses during prerequisite quarters to lower credit load during core sequence see AHE advisor for planning.
